#### Pupils behaviour

Rewarding children for good behaviour is at the centre of our behaviour policy.

Some children may have individualised reward programmes, these vary in nature and are designed with the child's needs at their heart.

#### Helping children make the right choice.

We work hard to encourage our pupils to make good choices. We understand that sometimes young children behave in a particular way for a variety of reasons.

First discuss with the child to ascertain the nature of the problem.

Remind the child of the choices they should make.
