### **Inspectors**

They will now revisit the school in the Autumn term to check on progress. The action plan is thorough and concise and will be summarised for you very soon. We will also be asking you to come into school to give your opinions on progress and how you think we could improve the school further. The children will also devise their own improvement plan according to the Estyn report. They always have the best ideas! So, it's a busy term ahead but an exciting one for everyone.

#### Reading

Reading standards were judged as unsatisfactory in the inspection. During the last term every child was tested in their reading and we now have a baseline reading age for all pupils from year 1 to 6. There are many children who are not reading well enough. We are now using catch up programs and changing to a more effective reading scheme. Your child must bring reading books home. If they are not bringing them home I need to know why! Please make sure you read with your child EVERY DAY. We want your child to be better readers too and you have an important part to play in this. The children who have support with reading at home make better progress than those who don't have help at home. We will be having reading events very soon if you need to know how to help your child with their reading.
