Breakfast club

We have had some problems with breakfast club recently. Doors open at 8.15am. Doors close at 8.30am. Your child cannot be let into the school after 8.30 so please ensure that you know they are supervised. Please do not leave them standing at the door and assume that they have entered the building. Teaching staff are on duty in the yard at 8.40am. Until then your child would be unsupervised. Breakfast club was set up for families with low income to ensure children eat well through the day. The club is not meant as a child minding service for parents to be able to go off to work, though we do recognise that some families use breakfast club as a means to start their own work at a particular time. Please can you respect this and ensure your child is well behaved during breakfast club and that they do eat the food provided. Breakfast club is organised and run by kitchen staff and not school staff. School staff help out with the organisation as we know parents rely on this service. Please help us by getting your child in by 8.30 and ensuring their behaviour is appropriate and that they listen to kitchen staff during that half hour.
