Inspection report

The school received the recent inspection report on Wednesday this week. The inspectors looked at 5 of the 9 recommendations whilst they were at the school. There are many positives in the report and the hard work is clearly having an effective on the pupils achievement. The recommendation states, "In order to maintain and improve on this progress, the school should continue to sustain the level of progress it has already made, and continue to address those inspection recommendations where further progress is required."

Inspectors will return in the Spring Term to check on progress as well as report on the remaining recommendations. The director of education will be inviting parents to meet with him in the new year to discuss the school's progress and answer any questions you may have.
