#### **Changing School Session Times**

#### Children's social skills on the return to school

We have spent time ensuring children have returned to school not only physically well but also emotionally and mentally. We do have some that are still settling into school and suffer with some anxieties.

Lockdown has deprived the children of developing and maintaining fiendships. It is important that we understand that the children have had little contact with friends and then placed into a situation where they are surrounded by all their friends all at one time!! Relationships need building again and some children

need more support with this than others. Relationships sometimes need repairing and we are spending time helping children in this process also.

Can we please ask that if you have any concerns contact the class teacher in the first instance. Please avoid trying to reslove matters outside the school gates with parents. This is a delicate time for the children and rebuilding children's confidence and social skills is part of our recovery programme in school.
